

How to Redirect HTTP to HTTPS with IIS 7

In IIS, to redirect (force) HTTPS on every HTTP request, do the following.

Before you start, make sure you have the following done;

- [IIS 7](#) installed
- [Microsoft URL Rewrite Module](#) installed
- Create [HTTPS bindings](#) to your IIS website and assign certificate
- Ensure [Require SSL is NOT](#) checked under SSL Settings for your website

Once you have this done you can simply copy and paste the following code between the `<and >` tags in your your **web.config** file in your website root directory.

Please note if you already have some rules in you **web.config** file, make sure to put the bellow rule within `<allRules>`. Every rule ends with `</rule>` and then `</allRules>` end with `</rules>`, so make sure not to put this rule inside another rule.

Now save the **web.config** file and it's all done.
